204 Committee – Chairman Cindy Klatt

This committee is responsible for addressing the issue of properties deemed derelict in the park. Its responsibilities include recommendation and completion of corrective action as approved by the board.

The committee reviews properties in the park that are not up to park standards and after board approval, will have the properties cleaned. They will charge the owner if the owner does not respond to the request to properly maintain their property.

Architectural and Compliance – Chaired by LanceMacArthur

The purpose of the Architectural committee is to guide and enforce compliance of Desert Crest, Riverside County and HUD rules for homeowners' building and improvement projects.

Emergency Preparedness and Safety Committee – Chaired by Lance Mac Arthur

The mission of this committee is to minimize the loss of life and damage to property during acts of destruction, by creating awareness of potential dangers, encouraging the remedy or mitigation of these threats to our person and property, by obtaining and maintaining emergency gear and supplies to teach you to be self-sufficient for a fourteen-day period. We provide necessary training opportunities to all residents to improve their skills and enhance everyone's chance of survival in case of a disaster.

Complaints Committee – Chaired by Virgilia Becker

Complaints are received by this committee and after logging, they are given to a board or a member of the Country Club to be resolved. The complainant is notified of the solution. All complaints are signed when received but remain anonymous after logged by the committee.

Recycling Committee – Chaired by Robin Johnson

This committee consists of Robin Johnson and his helpers, who work Mondays beginning at 8:00 am, checking recyclable items.
